### 3.0 General Discussion

### 3.1 Behavior

3.1.1 2022-2023 Behavior concerns

- How are we getting through the rest of this school year


### 3.1.2 2023-2024 Behavior expectations

- Are there clear expectations that all grades know?

PBIS is being worked through here at the school. This is a Tier 1 intervention.
Would like to use this to help incentivize positive behavior

- Implementation of incentives for student behavior

How can we implement a school wide behavior tracking system?

- Maybe use a ticket system for a raffle. Students can earn them weekly and draw on Friday to win a prize. Reset weekly. (Think Eagle Eyes)
- Specialists would like to find a way to incentivize 10 's with the classrooms.


### 3.2 Attendance update

- How are we trending?

Our attendance is approximately $30.8 \%$ currently. It is slightly lower than our peak number of $32 \%$.

- Status on accountability and follow-up being done by school

We are still recognizing students for their effort (completing all coursework)

- The district is allowing attendance awards, but it can't be for perfect attendance. It can be for students who have turned attendance around as well as students with few absences.
- Is there something the school can do to make sure parents understand how vacations or just letting students stay home truly affects their student?
