3.3 Update on Mrs. Ginnett's lessons to improve student survey result about bullying

3.3a. Any progress being made? Positive results?

Mrs. Ginnett has been posting on Class Dojo about her lessons.

Ms Watkis talked to Mrs. Ginnett about terminology that the students don't understand. Focusing on the terminology for Mean Moments, Teasing, and Bullying

Around 11-13 bullying reports to date. Some are repeat offenders.

Share with the parents the terminology.

Do a possible parent education session to share terminology and know what the students are learning about. Couple with a preexisting night.

3.4 WIN data (Ms. Watkis)

Schools are being instructed to use Core 95 phonics instead of HMH foundational skills (We are already using Core 95)

4 teachers in 5th grade are enrichment instead of 2

Less than 30 kids in 5th grade need phonics instruction

Increase of 10 (40 to 50) kids in 4th grade into test prep/enrichment

Lowest group in grade 3 has 6 kids (letter names and sounds)

In 3rd grade 35 students (was 17) in the highest groups

1st and 2nd grade are currently testing their students

Kindergarten will start their lowest 15 with instructional aides on Monday, November 20
